## Injury and Illness Reporting

If any member suffers an injury or illness, as a result of his or her duties while serving as a member of the Evansville Fire District, his/her medical expenses are covered by the provisions of the Worker's Compensation Act. An injured or ill member must immediately notify his/her Commanding officer or Fire Chief of the injury/illness and incident and complete appropriate paperwork.

## Physical and Mental Capabilities

Any fire fighter with heart disease, epilepsy, or emphysema, etc. shall make this information known to the Chief and will not be expected to perform tasks that may potentially harm them.

Any fire fighter that is claustrophobic, has a fear of heights or small spaces, etc. shall make this information known to the Chief and will not be expected to perform tasks that they do not feel safe doing.
